

Draft Community Outreach Schedule

Summary

The purpose of the community outreach effort is to provide information to the community, give transparency in the process and to allow the community to ask questions about the process. In effort to ensure that we hear from the community at all levels, we will focus our outreach efforts on reaching the largest racially and geographically diverse group of Saint Louis residents.

Key Steps:

We will meet with organizations such as; Sororities, Fraternities, Associations (Missouri Legislative Black Caucus, Black Banking Association, National Black MBA Association, National Black Accountants, Mound City Bar Association, Mound City Medical Forum, Black Nurses Association of Greater St. Louis), Community Organizations----Urban League, NAACP, etc., Churches, Neighborhood/Block Unit Meetings, Nursing Homes and Independent Living Facilities targeting senior residents.

The Community Outreach Team will target the above groups to communicate the overall idea and purpose for the Lambert International P3 Project. The Working Group will provide feedback on the overall communication message before sharing it with the community. The Community Outreach Team will work with the Working Group to determine appropriate number of meetings, communication level and message. Feedback survey will be given at each meeting to determine level of interest, understanding and support for the project.
